## **AAFPHC Club Code of Conduct**

- AAFPHC will help coaches and officials highlight appropriate behaviour and skill development, and help to improve the standards of coaching and officiating.
- AAFPHC will ensure that everyone involved in sport emphasises fair play, and not winning at all costs.
- AAFPHC will distribute a code of conduct to players, coaches, officials and parents and encourage them to follow it.
- AAFPHC will not tolerate bad language or behaviour from any member to any other player, coach, official or spectator at the club.
- AAFPHC will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
- AAFPHC will promote and adhere to anti-doping policies.
